Food to Flowers!

Lunchroom Composting

This school participates in the **Food to Flowers! Lunchroom Composting** program. Food to Flowers! is a school-based program that recycles leftover food scraps and food-soiled papers into compost. It is part of Sanitary Service Company's Food Plus! Recycling service. We encourage you to use this program during your event.

What can be composted?

Please compost ALL food scraps (even meat and dairy products), food-soiled papers — like paper napkins, cups, milk/soy cartons, juice boxes and paper towel waste in the Food Plus! toter (or the container set up by the custodial staff for your event). For waxed cardboard containers or boxes, please flatten and then place in toter. For a complete list of materials accepted see the label on the Food Plus! Recycling toter or visit www.ssc-inc.com.

What can be recycled?

This school recycles too — please recycle all scrap paper (bags, notepapers, agendas, programs, receipts, ticket stubs, posters, etc.), plastic bottles, glass bottles and jars, tin cans, aluminum cans, foil and cardboard boxes. Ask the school custodian for details.

Planning your event — tips and ideas

Does your event include food or beverages? Consider these tips to help make your event low-waste and compost-friendly.

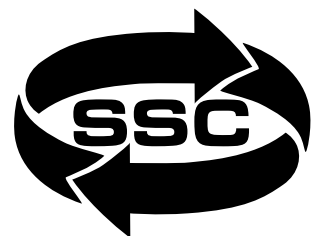
Consider using reusable dishware. Did you know ReSources (a local, non-profit organization) offers a dishware sharing program? They have dozens of utensils (knives, forks and spoons), dinner plates, dessert plates and coffee mugs available for use at no charge by community organizations. Paper vs. plastic

If reusable dishes won't work for your event consider paper products, including paper plates, napkins, cold cups and hot cups instead of plastic ware.
