Category D – \$45/item

Oversize Items: Larger than 20"L x 20"W x 20"H

- TV’s - Big Screen, Standard, Projection or Wood Console - 20-40" in any one dimension
- Photo Copiers / Station Printers under 40" in any dimension
- Monitors (over 20")

Category D – \$70/item

- Power Supplies - large Any item over 40" in any one dimension

NOTE: Rechargeable batteries must be attached to item for recycling. Non-rechargeable batteries should be thrown in the trash.
