Recycling / Garbage

Collection Information

House / Duplex

Recycle materials in your marked stacking bins. Set out full bins only in a visible location by 6:30am on your collection day. If windy, set bins in a row to prevent tipping and litter.

Apartment / Condo

Recycle materials by placing them in the marked recycling Toters®.

Bottles, Cans & Plastic Containers

Aluminum Cans, Tin Cans, Aerosol Cans & Foil: Remove tin can labels (recycle with mixed paper). Rinse clean. **FLATTEN** all aluminum cans, tin cans and foil products. Non-hazardous, aerosol cans **ONLY**. Aerosol cans must be **EMPTY** - no pressure or contents left in can. Leave cap on (if you have it). Place in cardboard box *next to* recycling bins. Hazardous product aerosol cans must be recycled through Disposal of Toxics (360) 380-4640.



No oil filters or air filters.

Glass Bottles & Jars: All colors accepted.



Labels and lids OK. Remove metal lids and place loose in bins.

Rinse clean. Avoid breaking glass. Bottles must be removed from 6-pak and 1/2 case boxes, etc. and placed loose in bin.

No window glass, windshields, Pyrex, light bulbs (incandescent), mirrors or ceramics.

Plastic Containers: Bottles, jugs, caps & rings, cups, jars, tubs, pails, buckets & lids (max. bucket size - 1 gal. with metal handles removed)

All colors and numbers accepted. Labels OK. Rinse lids and containers **CLEAN** and recycle nested together if possible. Please **FLATTEN** all plastic bottles and put the plastic caps/lids back on to increase hauling capacity in our recycling trucks and prevent litter.



Recycle plastic containers used for these types of products:

Beverages, dairy products, deli foods, sauces/condiments, cooking oils, soaps, detergents, cleaners (kitchen, laundry & garage), snack foods, frozen foods, storage/freezer containers, hair/body care, health/medicine, single-serve cold beverage cups/lids and hot beverage lids.

No plastic pumps, Styrofoam™, clamshell containers, tableware/utensils, pipe, toys, foam rubber, insulation or plastic containers that held potentially hazardous products such as motor oil, antifreeze, solvents, paint, pesticides, etc.

Newspaper



Clean newsprint, inserts and ads. Maximum bin weight 35 lbs.

If windy, put top layer of newspaper in a paper bag to prevent litter.

No plastic bags please.

Mixed Paper

Old mail, magazines, catalogs, stationery, envelopes, computer, copy and notebook paper, paper labels, cartons and bags, shoe and cereal boxes (remove liners and break down completely or fill with mixed paper to save space). Maximum bin weight 35 lbs.



If windy, put top layer of papers in a paper bag to prevent litter. No plastic bags please. Please place shredded paper in paper bag to prevent litter.

No plastic bags, paper towels, plates, napkins, wax or plastic-coated boxes or papers (i.e. milk, juice or frozen food containers), plastic, foil, tissue or carbon paper or products made with multiple materials (i.e. paperboard sides w/ metal bottoms). NOTE: If you live in an area where our FoodPlus! Recycling program is available AND you subscribe to this service, you can recycle these types of compostable paper items in your FoodPlus! Recycling Toter® (except foil-lined paper or multi-layered products).

Other Recyclables - Set next to bins, not in bin

All Customers: Recycle these items by placing them next to recycling Toters® or bins.

Cardboard: Corrugated cardboard and brown paper bags. Remove packing materials and excess staples or tape. Please break down all boxes completely and lay flat on ground. Please keep cardboard pieces smaller than 24"W x 48"L. Maximum 6" high stack per pick-up. If windy, bundle or tape stack or place something heavy on stack (i.e. rock or recycle bin) to prevent blowing. For pick-up of larger stacks, call SSC at 734-3490. *No Styrofoam™, plastic packing or wax-coated boxes (ie. fruit, vegetable boxes).*

Motor Oil: Store in a one gallon or smaller, sealed, non-breakable container like a plastic milk jug (do not use bleach or water bottles). Mark container "Oil."

Used motor oil only. Do not mix with water, brake fluid, antifreeze, debris, paint thinner or other solvents.

Scrap Metal: Steel, copper, aluminum and brass. Maximum 35 lbs. per pick up. Maximum length 24 inches. *Store in a box or paper bag. No plastic pipe.*

Batteries: Car, truck, motorcycle and boat batteries.

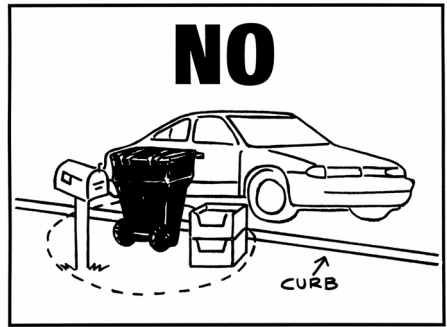
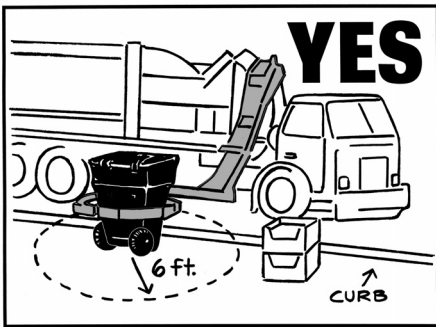
Store in a box or paper bag. No cracked or leaking batteries. Leave battery caps on. Household batteries can now be safely disposed of in the trash.

Automated Garbage Truck Collection Info

Your route may be serviced by one of our automated garbage trucks. Our automated garbage collection trucks require more space around containers for pick-up. Please place garbage Toter(s)®:

- At the curb, with the handle away from the street/alley
 - With at least 6 feet of clear space around all sides
- Do not place Toter(s)® near garbage containers, recycling bins, trees, shrubs, telephone poles, mailboxes, parked cars, etc.
 - Please remove cords and straps before pick-up.
 - On windy days, place a rock or brick on Toter® lid to prevent tipping and litter.
